



## General Council

Number 113 - May - June 2024

*The new General Government held its first ordinary session from 20 May to 13 June 2024 at the Casa Generalizia in Rome.*

*The first part was devoted to resuming the work of the General Chapter. During this session, the General Government prepared the official texts of the Chapter, which will be sent to the communities in July. It also defined the themes for the next 6 years.*

*Following the General Chapter elections, the Superior General also appointed new Major Superiors, which required time for consultation, discernment and decisions. The Council warmly thanks all the brothers who have accepted to take on the role of Major Superior.*

## 1. Animation of the Congregation

### 1.1 General Chapter

A great deal of work was carried out after the Chapter to format the final texts. The General Council salutes the precise work of the various secretaries: they greatly contributed to the smooth running of our General Chapter. Particular thanks go to Brother Philippe Blot, who has completed the Chapter booklet, which is currently being printed. Thanks also to the translators!

### 1.2 Theme of the Year

The Congregation's theme for 2024-2025 is part of the spiritual journey proposed by the Church in preparation for the Jubilee "**Pilgrims of Hope**", which begins on 24 December 2024.

Pope Francis has proposed that the year 2024 be dedicated to **prayer**: "*I am already delighted to think that the year preceding the jubilee event, 2024, could be dedicated to a great 'symphony' of prayer, first and foremost to rediscover the desire to be in the presence of the Lord, to listen to him and to adore him*".

Taking into account the General Government's choice to animate the Institute on the basis of our new Rule of Life, the theme chosen for the year 2024-2025 is: "**Pilgrims on the path of Prayer**". This will be a great opportunity for the Brothers to discover Chapter 7, on the life of prayer.



The Major Superiors, together with some Brothers responsible for animation in their Provinces or Districts, have already discovered the theme for the year during an online session.

### 1.3 Rule of Life :

---

The members present at the General Chapter certainly echoed the good work that went into writing the new Rule of Life. Some adjustments have been made recently.

The new Rule of Life adopted by the Capitulants will be submitted to the Dicastery of Consecrated Life during the month of June, for approval of the Constitutions.

We will have to wait for the Dicastery's response before the final publication of the Rule.

### 1.4 A 4<sup>th</sup> Brother Assistant :

---

A new provision of the Directory adopted by the Chapter states:

*"In the interval between two ordinary General Chapters, the Brother Superior General may add a new member to the General Council.*

*By a first collegial vote, the Brother Superior General and his Council will first decide on the advisability of adding a new Assistant. Then, if necessary, they will proceed collegially to elect the new Brother Assistant, by secret ballot and by a two-thirds majority of the votes.*

*The newly elected Assistant is a member of the Council until the next General Chapter. (Ch. 14, 58.1)*

After a period of discussion and discernment, the members of the General Government collectively voted in favour of a 4th Assistant.

❖ **The General Government, by collegial vote, elects Brother Gildas Prigent, Assistant General until the next General Chapter.**

The members of the General Government thank Brother Gildas Prigent for having accepted this responsibility. They wish him a successful mission in the service of the Congregation.

### 1.5 Saint-Peter Chanel (French Polynesia) Delegation

---

For several months, the Brothers and Communities of Polynesia (Tahiti and Marquesas) have been involved in the reflection on the future of their District, as of now, made up of 8 Brothers in 3 communities.

❖ ***The Superior General, with the consent of his Council, decides to erect the Communities of the Marquesas Islands and Tahiti into the Saint-Pierre-Chanel Delegation, with effect from 1st July 2024.***

❖ ***The Superior General, with the consent of his Council, adopts the Statutes of the Delegation.***

❖ ***The Superior General appoints Brother Gildas Prigent as Delegate of the Superior General for the Polynesia Delegation***

### **Missionaries to East Timor**

The last Echoes of the General Council gave the information of the decision to open a new mission in East Timor, in the diocese of Baucau. The Superior General, with the consent of his Council, appoints :

Philippe Douli (District Saint-Paul)  
and Christian Usengimana (District Saint John Paul II)**

members of the future mission in the diocese of Baucau, East Timor. He appointed Brother Stéphane Le Pape, Superior of the Community and Head of the mission for a mandate of 3 years.

On **15 September 2024**, at the Brothers' Mother House at Ploërmel, these three Brothers will be sent on mission.

From the beginning of October until December, the three Brothers will travel to Portugal for a time to learn Portuguese in Lisbon. A community of Marist Brothers will be hosting them.

In January 2025, they will travel to Dili (Capital of East Timor) for several months learning Tetum (the local language). They will be housed in a community of the Society of the Divine Word (SDV). In April 2025, they will settle in the town of Manatuto, Diocese of Baucau.

The entire Congregation is already praying for them and wishes Brothers Stéphane, Philippe and Christian a wonderful and holy mission!

### **Projects Office**

The Superior General and his Council have decided to set up a Projects Office, to be based at the Casa Generalizia in Rome.

1. assist the Provinces and Districts in drawing up investment projects: communities, schools and other works, equipment, ...
2. seek funding; to act as an interface between donors and those responsible for projects in the Provinces and Districts;
3. monitor project implementation;
4. supervise project accounting
5. reporting to donors and the Institute.
